FRESH FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PROGRAM: Did you know that the students at Thayne Elementary have a fruit or vegetable snack every day, provided through the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program? It's a great opportunity for students to taste a wide variety of produce including items such as Santa Claus melons, Jicama, Forelle pears, grape tomatoes, apples, carrots, etc. As well as tasting the fruits and vegetables, students learn about each item. For example: Did you know . . . raspberries are sold by color not variety. Or, how to pick a good watermelon . . . turn over. 


NURSE NOTES

Public Health in partnership with LCSD#2 is providing a kindergarten vaccination clinic for your convenience at kindergarten registration.

We will be offering the DTaP (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis), IPV (Polio), MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), and Varicella (chickenpox) vaccines, which are required for entry into kindergarten. This clinic is a public service provided by LCSD#2 and Lincoln County Public Health with vaccines provided by the Wyoming Department of Health's Vaccines for Children Program.





Wednesday, May 9th: Thayne Elementary 5:00 - 7:00 p.m.

This clinic is in conjunction with KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION for the 2018-19 school year. We will have Vaccine Information Statements, Notice of Privacy Practices and consent forms available. We can only immunize properly if we have your child/children's previous immunization records, so please make sure to have those with you. We accept most insurance (we are in network with Blue Cross Blue Shield, Cigna, Medicaid, and United Healthcare - all others are considered out of network). Please bring your insurance cards with you. The vaccine itself is free of charge; however, we do ask for an administration fee of \$20 per shot (even so, we do not turn anyone away because of inability to pay).

Please take advantage of this opportunity to get your kindergarten student's immunizations up to date. If you have any questions, please call Lincoln County Public Heath at 885-9598. Thank you.
