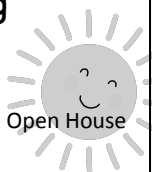

- Dropping Off Students -

Our student drop off area is located in the front of the building near the flagpole. Please pull up as far as you can. Students can then exit their vehicles and enter the building through the main entrance.

- Picking Up Students -

Please check in at the main office to pick up your student during the school day. If you are picking up your student after school, please wait for your child at the student drop off/pick up area near the flagpole. A staff member will escort students from their classrooms to meet parents/guardians at the drop off/pick up area.

IMPORTANT kindergarten INFORMATION:

Kindergarten: August 20 & 21 there will be no school for Kindergarten students.

Instead, parents can sign up to meet with their child's teacher and to take care of beginning-of-year student assessments.

DRESS CODE:

- Tight-fitting or overly loose clothing that is revealing is not acceptable.
